SPD, Solid (1)

1 Ellison's Spinoza of Merrily avec Withiflor (IMP FRA). B/T youngster of good make and shape. Lovely head, so well balanced along with a kind eye and the softest of expressions. Well developed body for his age with a good spring of rib and pleasing depth. Nicely rounded hindquarters and a good tailset. Once he settled moved soundly.

SJD, Solid (1)

1 Flowers Inverella Iceman. Compact cockery red of overall pleasing confirmation. Pleasing head, correct square muzzle and a good eye and expression. Clean front with a good depth of chest and plenty of heartroom. Big ribs and a strong short loin. Moved soundly both fore and aft.

- 1 Kew's Lujesa Starman at Wylyeview. Well balanced black of good type and presents a very typical outlook both stacked and on the move. Liked his head and expression. Stands on good legs and feet, good body shape and a correct topline and tailset. Pleasing quarters with a good bend of stifle. Sound and positive on the move.
- 2 McShane's Obsidian Spring Marvel at Meggiemac. Black of excellent bone and substance throughout. Balanced head, good depth of chest and a well developed body. Pleasing spring of rib and nicely angulated hindquarters which are not exaggerated in anyway. Moved well. Not as compact as the winner.

SPD, AOC (2,1)

1 Madigan's Misperros Dezign In Siver. Stood alone but a very worthy winner. Good size and presents a clean and balanced outlook. Best of heads, very typical throughout with a good eye and kind expression. Scores in front assembly. Pleasing body for his age, best of quarters and well let down hocks. Moved soundly on a good stride.

- 1 Cassidy's Manchela Speechless at Cassoz. Cracking young man who I liked a lot and with a few more months on his back should be pushing for top honours. One of the best heads I judged on the day. Excellent reach of neck set in well placed shoulders. Good depth of chest, firm topline that he keeps on the move, correct tailset and well developed hindquarters. Very sound both fore and aft.
- 2 Collin's Bartonholme Prince of Tides at Candyke. Another who impressed with his very cockery outlook and was unlucky to meet the winner on such form on the day. Balanced head with a good eye and expression. Best of legs and feet, well sprung ribs, excellent substance throughout and strong well made quarters. Moved well.
- 3 Lewis's Penmartin Bright Knight.

- 1 Manchela Speechless at Cassoz.
- 2 Bowen's Larath Hobson's Choice. Very pleasing sort, well balanced, compact and stands four square. Best of heads with a lovely dark eye and the softest of expressions. Clean over the neck and shoulders, big ribs, short loin and correct topline and tailset. Nicely rounded hindquarters and a good bend of stifle. Moved soundly.

SOD, AOC (4,1)

- 1 Armstrong's Sh.Ch.Glenbriar Grand Dezsign (IMP AUS) Such a sound and honest dog who just flows from head to tail. Good size with excellent bone and substance and presents a very typical outlook. Balanced head with a good square muzzle. Best of fronts with a pleasing reach of neck and a good layback of shoulder. Well sprung ribs and powerful quarters. Really comes into his own on the move, so sound with excellent reach and drive, CC.
- 2 Lowery's Amarone Theos JW. Different stamp and style from the winner but a very good Cocker of excellent make and shape. Good head with a very typical outlook and a pleasing eye and expression. Well made front assembly standing on good legs and feet. Compact body, nicely rounded hindquarters, one with a 'bum'. Moved well both fore and aft.
- 3 Blazejczak's Summer Vibes Perfekt Partner.

- 1 Ellison's Sh.Ch.Withiflor Rolling Sone JW. Lovely example of the breed who has kept his shape and balance throughout. Excellent head so typical, cleanly chissiied as the standard asks for, dark eye and the softest of expressions. Very clean over the neck and shoulders. Well boned, good feet, excellent spring of rib and pleasing quarters with a good bend of stifle. Moved well. BVIS.
- 2 Collin's Cassom Sky Rocket at Candyke JW. Very cockery throughout and has that cobby appearance which is such a trait of the breed. Pleasing head and a well made front assembly. Plenty of bone and substance, nice spring of rib and a good width of hindquarters. Moved well both fore and aft.
- 3 Cox's Sh.Ch.Gardenstone Pale Rider to Suvern JW.

MPD (8,1)

- 1 Share-Jones Sharemead Golden Spark. Very promising young man who is just right for his age. Well made throughout and has that merry and sturdy appearance as the breed requires. Typical in head with a kind eye and the best of expressions. Best of fronts, well bodied and a good spring of rib. Correct topline and a pleasing tailset. Once he got into his stride moved soundly.
- 2 Winder's Harbethol Look That's Magic for Kevuliawin. Smart puppy of good type. Very well balanced throughout with lovely bone and substance for his age. Good head, eye and expression. Pleasing reach of neck set in well placed shoulders. Short cobby body and lovely well rounded quarters, another one with a 'bum'. Sound on the move.
- 3 Spinoza of Merrily avec Withiflor (IMP FRA)

- 1 Williams Wilmerella Outlander. Cracking youngster out of the top draw who I am sure will have a very promising future if he continues on these lines. Good size and so well made throughout. Lovely head that just says Cocker Spaniel, balanced with a good eye and soft expression. Scores in front assembly. Excellent legs and feet, well sprung ribs for his age and the best of hindquarters. Soundest of movers. BPIS.
- 2 Beswick's Esqueen Give A Gift for Cachel (IMP POL). Very pleasing sort with a very typical outlook but not as forward as the winner on the day. Pleasing head and eye. Well boned throughout, lovely depth of chest for his age with plenty of heartroom. Short compact body and well made quarters with a pleasing bend of stifle. Moved well.
- 3 Harbethol Look That's Magic for Kevuliawin.

JD (4)

- 1 Chapman's Chativore Blenheim Blue. Smaller framed dog but still has a masculine outlook and is very well balanced throughout. Good head and expression. Pleasing length of neck set in well placed shoulders. Well sprung ribs, firm topline that he holds on the move and a good tailset and carriage. Nicely rounded hindquarters and well let down hocks. Moved soundly.
- 2 Holland's Crimicar Indigo Magic. Lots to like about him. Good size and has that merry nature that is such a characteristic of the breed. Balanced head with a good eye and expression. Well off for bone and substance, good legs and feet, pleasing quarters and a good bend of stifle. Very sound on the move.
- 3 Wright's La Scales Berlin with Chazbaz (IMP HUN)

- 1 Manchela Speechless at Cassoz.
- 2 Share-Jones Sharemead Hendricks. Another good one from this kennel who pushed the winner close. Good size and is not exaggerated in anyway presenting a very typical outlook and built on clean lines. Pleasing head. Best of fronts, excellent depth of chest with plenty of heartroom, well developed body and good width of hindquarters. Presented in good order. Soundest of movers.
- 3 Terry's Shaggylands Desperate Dan.

ND (2)

- 1 Birkenshaw's Gilcar Midnight Dream. Fits the standard well and has that cobby appearance that says Cocker Spaniel. Good head, eye and expression. Clean front standing on the best of legs and feet. Excellent bone throughout, well sprung ribs, short strong loin and a pleasing topline and tailset. Well rounded quarters with a good bend of stifle. Positive on the move.
- 2 Chativore Blenheim Blue.

PGD(8)

1 Torbett's Taylor Made. Took my eye as soon as he entered the ring with his typical outlook and super side gait on the move. Good size, very well balanced and has lovely bone and substance throughout. Typical in head with a lovely dark eye and kind expression. Scores in front assembly, good depth of chest with plenty of heartroom, powerful hindquarters that he uses to advantage on the move. Very well presented. So sound fore and aft. Res.CC.

2 Rahman & Williams Sensqui Blackout. One I judged as a very raw baby, liked him then and has fulfilled that early promise and pushed the winner close on the day. Balanced head with a pleasing eye and expression. Strong muscular neck set in well placed shoulders, level topline that he holds on the move and well made quarters with a pleasing bend of stifle. Moved well both fore and aft.

3 Driver's Annilann Mister Spangles at Beckaby JW.

SBD (4,1)

- 1 Mason's Sandlauga Soul Man. Excellent bone and substance throughout but shows no sign of coarseness. Pleasing head with a kind eye and soft expression. Clean over the neck and shoulders, excellent depth of chest and well sprung ribs. Nicely rounded hindquarters. Very sound and positive mover.
- 2 Reader's Cachel Beachboy at Kaniboo. Good size with a very pleasing balanced outline both stacked and on the move. Typical in head with a good eye and expression. Stands on good legs and feet, well bodied and good width of quarters. Moved well but not as positive in front as the winner on the day.
- 3 Chativore Blenheim Blue.

LD (9,2)

- 1 Keely's Oakbeach Dare To Dream Big with Alhambian (IMP SWE). One I have admired from the ringside and was not disappointed when I got my hands on him. Good size of dog with lovely bone and substance throughout and with that cobby outlook that typifies the breed. Balanced head, clean cut and with a dark eye and gentle expression. Best of fronts, well sprung ribs and the best of hindquarters. Soundest of movers with good reach and drive.
- 2 Palmer's Tarrendayle Forever Yours at Robraine (IMP AUS). Beautifully balanced throughout and built on clean and flowing lines. Lovely head, masculine and with a kind eye and soft expression. Scores in neck and shoulders, good depth of chest, correct topline and tailset and very well made quarters. Sound on the move both fore and aft.
- 3 Jenkins Bruxly Bandolero.

OD (10,2)

1 Todd & Rahman's Chataway Hijacked. One of the few I have judged before and has really developed into a quality dog with a very typical outlook. Good size and very well balanced throughout. Pleasing head, eye and expression. Strong neck with a good layback of shoulder and correct return of upper arm. Well sprung ribs and pleasing hindquarters with a good bend of stifle. Positive on the move.

2 Morris's Sh.Ch.Riondel Candyman JW. Well made, squarely built and with excellent bone and substance throughout. Balanced head with a good dark eye and pleasing expression. Very clean over the neck and shoulders, best of legs and feet, scores in body, level topline and correct tailset. Nicely rounded quarters and well let down hocks. Moved well.
